Throughout this document fees are expressed in <u>Thai Baht per year</u>. If a student joins the school during a year, all fees are charged pro rata.

Remark:

- Residential: Different accommodation arrangements are made by gender.
 - Weekly board means Monday morning to Friday evening.
 - o Boarding fee includes 3 meals a day and snacks.
 - Students from G7-G12 may choose to use the school washing machine for their own laundry at no cost. Detergent is the student's responsibility.
- Registration deposit G5–G6 50,000 Baht G7–G12 80,000 Baht is included in the tuition, non-refundable and deducted from 2nd semester tuition, and payable upon acceptance for new students. For returning students, the deposit is due and payable by June 1st.
- Application fee is one-off payment and non-refundable. Payable when application is submitted.
- **Entrance fee** is one-off payment and non-refundable. Payable upon acceptance.
- Miscellaneous account is deposited money by parents to cover educational field trips, a copy of the Yearbook for each family each year, a headphone (Grade 5 and 6), educational equipment and material use. Uniforms may also be paid for out of this account. Any money remaining when a student leaves the school is returned after the accountant is sure that all expenses have been covered.
 - o **Grades 11 and 12 Miscellaneous Fee:** include costs for the IB Diploma Programme covering exam fees, essential resources, and other charges from the International Baccalaureate to ensure comprehensive support for students' academic success.

PLEASE NOTE: Based on students individual needs there may be times during the year that the miscellaneous fund may need to have extra funds added by the parent.

- Chromebook fee (Grades 5-6) is for the chromebook equipped with an APIS chromebook license, ensuring safe internet access and blocking inappropriate content. The Chromebook serves as a critical learning tool, tailored for secure and productive use in the classroom. Students in Grades 5-6 are required to purchase a Chromebook from the school.
- Classroom Without Walls (CWW) is a compulsory program to further promote and develop learning outside the classroom. There is an annual Classroom Without Walls week for G7–G11. G12 travels after final exams in May. The fee varies based on year level.

Additional Fees:

English Language Learning (ELL) is an additional education support program for students from G5 whose
native language is not English. This additional support program need will be determined by the classroom
teacher, the ELL teacher and the administration, based on classroom performance and formalized
assessments. The fee is non-refundable for any withdrawal before the school year ends.

Transportation:

- Day student 22,500 Baht/year from Primary Campus to Main Campus and from Main Campus to Primary Campus. It is also available from home to Main Campus and from Main Campus to home at an additional cost according to distance.
- Weekly residential student 6,500 Baht/year from Primary Campus to Main Campus on Monday morning and from Main Campus to Primary Campus on Friday evening. It is also available from home to Main Campus and from Main Campus to home at an additional cost according to distance.
- o Free for the full board between the airport and the Main Campus.

PAYMENT DATES

Many families choose to pay fees in full before the start of each school year. For those who wish to spread the payments, tuition and fees for current students are due and payable **before** the beginning of each semester as per below schedule:

- Registration deposit for the next school year is due and payable prior to getting the visa letter.
- Tuition and fees for the First Semester starting August are due and payable by June 1st.
- Tuition and fees for the Second Semester starting January are due and payable by December 1st.
- Payments not made by the due date will be subject to a 1.5% per month surcharge.

OVERDUE PAYMENT

Where fees are not paid by the due date, the school reserves the right to proceed as follows:

- 1. Withhold all school documents including the grade report.
- 2. Discontinue enrollment of the following academic year.
- 3. Suspend from testing and all previous scores will be withheld.
- 4. Take legal action in the collection of outstanding fees.

REFUND POLICIES

1. Withdrawal

- Application, Entrance and Deposit Fees are non-refundable.
- No refund for tuition, residential, transportation or lunch fees if a student has attended for any part of the semester.
- If fees are paid annually, then a portion of tuition (less deposit), residential, transportation and meal fees will be refunded if a student decides to withdraw before the start of a semester and has provided written notice of intention to withdraw at least 30 days before the start of the semester.

2. Sicknesses

- Partial tuition refund will be considered if the student must withdraw from the school for serious health reasons. The original reliable medical sickness certificate from the certified hospital with a proper reason explaining the symptoms and medical treatments should be provided to school. Such requests will be evaluated on a case by case basis.
