Throughout this document fees are expressed in <u>Thai Baht per year</u>. f a student joins the school during a year, all fees are charged pro rate.

Remark:

• Registration deposit Pre-N – G6 50,000 Baht

is included in the tuition, non-refundable and deducted from 2nd semester tuition, and payable upon acceptance for new students. For returning students, the deposit is due and payable by June 1st.

- Application fee is one-off payment and non-refundable. Payable when application is submitted.
- Entrance fee is one-off payment and non-refundable. Payable upon acceptance.
- Chromebook fee (Grades 3-6) is for the chromebook equipped with an APIS chromebook license, ensuring safe internet access and blocking inappropriate content. The Chromebook serves as a critical learning tool, tailored for secure and productive use in the classroom. Students in Grades 3-6 are required to purchase a Chromebook from the school.
- **Miscellaneous account** is deposited money by parents to cover educational field trips, a copy of the Yearbook for each family each year, a headphone (K3-G6), educational equipment and materials use. Uniforms may also be paid for out of this account. Any money remaining when a student leaves the school is returned after the accountant is sure that all expenses have been covered.

PLEASE NOTE: Based on students individual needs there may be times during the year that the miscellaneous fund may need to have extra funds added by parents.

• **Classroom Without Walls (CWW)** is the compulsory trip program to further promote and develop learning outside the classroom. The fee varies on year level.

Additional Fees:

• English Language Learning (ELL) is an additional education support program for students from G1 whose native language is not English. This additional support program need will be determined by the classroom teacher, the ELL teacher and the administration, based on classroom performance and formalized assessments. The fee is non-refundable for any withdrawal before the school year ends.

• **Transportation costs** are available between home and Primary Campus at an additional cost according to distance.

Transfer to American Pacific International School (Main Campus)

The students who complete the school year and wish to transfer to American Pacific International School in upper grades will not be required to pay new application and entrance fees.

PAYMENT DATES

Many families choose to pay fees in full before the start of each school year. For those who wish to spread the payments, tuition and fees for current students are due and payable before the beginning of each semester as per below schedule:

- **Registration deposit** for the **next school year** is due and payable prior to getting the visa letter.
- Tuition and fees for the First Semester starting August are due and payable by June 1st.
- Tuition and fees for the Second Semester starting January are due and payable by December 1st.
- Payments not made by the due date will be subject to a **1.5% per month surcharge**.

OVERDUE PAYMENT

Where fees are not paid by the due date, the school reserves the right to proceed as follows:

- 1. Withhold all school documents including the grade report.
- 2. Discontinue enrollment of the following academic year.
- 3. Suspend from testing and all previous scores will be withheld.
- 4. Take legal action in the collection of outstanding fees.

REFUND POLICIES

1. Withdrawal

- Application, Entrance and Deposit Fees are non-refundable.
- No refund for tuition, transportation or lunch fees if a student has attended for any part of the semester.
- If fees are paid annually, then a portion of tuition (less deposit), residential, transportation and meal fees will be refunded if a student decides to withdraw before the start of a semester and has provided written notice of intention to withdraw at least 30 days before the start of the semester.

2. Sicknesses

 Partial tuition refund will be considered if the student must withdraw from the school for serious health reasons. The original reliable medical sickness certificate from the certified hospital with a proper reason explaining the symptoms and medical treatments should be provided to school. Such requests will be evaluated on a case by case basis.

ADMISSIONS

Documents required for admissions:

- 1. completed application form
- 2. 2 color photographs attached to the application form
- 3. 2 color photographs of parents
- 4. records from previous school for two years

For Thai students:

- 1. a photocopy of student birth certificate
- 2. a photocopy of house registration (Thai)
- 3. a photocopy of medical records (Immunization)
- 4. a photocopy of parentsID (Thai)

For International students:

- 1. a photocopy of student's birth certificate
- 2. a photocopy of student's passport and visa
- 3. a photocopy of a parent's passport and visa
- 4. in case of a student visa requirement only :
 - a. completed history check up form for both student and parent
 - b. completed purpose of attending the school form
 - c. School will prepare necessary documents for visa process (please see the student visa process) only after we receive the deposit payment.
